

PRESIDENT TRUMP

ECONOMY:

- President Trump built the world's strongest economy once before and he will do it again.
- In fact, the recovery process has already begun. President Trump is currently leading our nation through the Great American Comeback. Recent successes include...
 - In June, a massive 4.8 million jobs were added – double what was added in May and blowing past expectations by 2 million.
 - The stock market has reached record highs under President Trump.
 - This year, the NASDAQ hit a record high, topping 10,000 for the first time ever.
- Despite the artificial economic interruption that is COVID-19, Americans and Georgians are prospering under President Trump.
 - Under President Trump, 5.6 million people have come off food stamps.
 - Since President Trump took office 2.4 million Americans have been lifted out of poverty.
- Prior to COVID-19, the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) was crucial to Georgia's economy.
 - The average tax cut in Georgia was \$1,262.
 - TCJA generated 6,526 jobs in Georgia in 2018.
 - TCJA also doubled the Child Tax Credit, which nearly 40 million families benefited from in tax year 2019.

WORKFORCE/KEY INDUSTRIES:

- Prior to COVID-19, after President Trump was elected, Georgia's unemployment rate has decreased from 5.3% to 3.1%.
- In light of COVID-19, President Trump passed the CARES Act/Paycheck Protection Program (PPP)
 - The PPP (a provision of the CARES Act) was hugely beneficial to Georgians, saving jobs and providing \$9.4 billion in relief loans to our state's small businesses.
 - Many economists credited the PPP with helping to jumpstart our Great American Comeback post-COVID.
- Georgia has added 15,700 manufacturing jobs since President Trump was elected.
 - Recently, President Trump has prioritized manufacturing/construction job creation. National gains include...
 - Manufacturing: 356,000 gain
 - Construction: 158,000 gain
- President Trump has made slashing unnecessary job-killing regulations a priority of his Administration.
 - The Administration has cut nearly 8 regulations for every new rule.
 - The deregulation efforts will save American households an estimated \$3,100 per year.

HEALTH CARE:

- President Trump has prioritized fixing our broken health care system and worked with Congress to implement a system that works for all Americans.
- The President has made it clear patients with preexisting conditions will be protected.
- The individual mandate penalty has been eliminated.
- President Trump called on Congress to support his administration's efforts to lower prescription drug prices for all Americans.
 - President Trump announced additional action to provide more affordable insulin options through Medicare.

OPIOID CRISIS:

- We are seeing first-hand the impact of the Trump Administration's fight to end the opioid epidemic, with data confirming fatal drug overdoses dropped in 2018 for the first time in nearly 30 years.
 - President Trump underscored his dedication to ending the epidemic of drug addiction when he declared it Nationwide Public Health Emergency.
- The President has mobilized his entire administration to help Americans struggling with addiction.

PAID FAMILY MEDICAL LEAVE:

- President Trump was the first President to include paid family leave in his budget.
- President Trump and his administration have advocated for America's working families by approving the largest paid parental leave program ever, guaranteeing 12 weeks of paid leave for all federal workers.

GREEN NEW DEAL:

- Our nation doesn't need a Green New Deal.
- The President and his Administration continue to pursue policies that encourage environmental protection while promoting economic growth.
 - Since 2005, our energy related carbon emissions have declined more than any other country. This is expected to decrease in 2019 and 2020.
- Our nation's environmental record is one of the strongest in the world. ○ According to the White House, from 1970 to 2018, the combined emissions of the most common air pollutants fell 74% while the economy grew over 275%.
- Georgia is a national leader in solar energy and we have more solar on military bases than any other state.
 - This even further underscores, at a state level, a lack of need for the Green New Deal.

SAVANNAH PORT EXPANSION:

- Recently, President Trump's [Fiscal Year 2021 Budget](#) requested full funding for the Savannah Harbor Expansion Project (SHEP). These improvements will complement continued progress on SHEP by increasing efficiency within the port's navigation channel.
- For Georgians and Americans, this means [\\$282 million](#) added to our economy each year.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING:

- The Administration has made it a priority to end human trafficking and is using many resources to do so.
 - Nine pieces of legislation aimed at combatting human trafficking and modern slavery have been signed into law by President Trump.
 - The Administration provided funding to support the National Human Trafficking Hotline.
 - The Anti-Trafficking Coordination Team (ACTeam) initiative more than doubled convictions of human traffickers and increased the number of defendants charged in ACTeam districts.
 - Trump Senior Advisor Ivanka Trump endorsed Georgia's HB823 which was signed into law on July 21.
 - The legislation bars anyone convicted of human trafficking from getting a commercial driver's license if their conviction involved driving a commercial vehicle.

RURAL BROADBAND:

- The Trump Administration is working to promote connectivity in rural American by investing in rural broadband.
 - Here in Georgia, expanding internet access is beneficial to the farming industry and advances in the industry's equipment.

INFRASTRUCTURE/TRAFFIC:

- In March 2017, a bridge on major interstate I-85 collapsed due to a fire. The Trump Administration led the way to repair the bridge ahead of schedule and under budget.
- President Trump issued changes to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) to reduce regulation and allow for infrastructure and transportation projects to move forward.
 - In Georgia, this will assist with projects like widening I-75.

COVID-19:

- President Trump and the White House Coronavirus Task Force are leading an unprecedented, comprehensive, and aggressive whole of America approach to slow the spread of the virus.
- The Administration's response began early.
 - On January 31, President Trump declared the coronavirus a public health emergency and suspended entry into the U. S to help stop the spread.
- In March, the President approved [Georgia's Major Disaster Declaration](#).
- President Trump continues to deliver crucial personal protective equipment (PPE) to Georgia and Georgia now has the ability to test every resident.

AGRICULTURE:

- In 2018, President Trump signed a sweeping new Farm Bill into law.
 - The Farm Bill provides support and stability to our farmers, expands crop insurance, doubles how much farmers can borrow and helps open new markets for our farmers.
- Red tape that has harmed American farmers has been rolled back.
 - This includes eliminating the burdensome Obama-era Waters of the United States rule.
- President Trump is standing up for America's farmers by negotiating fairer, freer, and more reciprocal trade deals that remove barriers and open markets for American farmers.
 - President Trump signed the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) into law.

HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES & UNIVERSITIES:

- President Trump has made Historically Black Colleges and Universities a priority, including appropriating more money to HBCUs in one year than any other president and establishing a Presidential Board of Advisors on HBCUs.
 - President Trump signed the FUTURE Act into law. The law permanently funds HBCUs and simplifies the FAFSA application.
- More recently, during the coronavirus pandemic, President Trump signed legislation that provided \$1 billion to HBCUs that were impacted by coronavirus.

MILITARY:

- Under President Trump's leadership, Congress passed three historic National Defense Authorization Acts (NDAA).
 - The FY2020 NDAA authorized a historic \$738 billion in defense spending.
 - The FY2020 NDAA includes a much needed 3.1% pay raise for our troops, the largest in a decade.
- President Trump signed the Veterans Accountability and Whistleblower Protection Act to allow senior officials in the Department of Veterans Affairs (V.A.) to fire failing employees and establish safeguards to protect whistleblowers.
- The administration expanded telehealth access for veterans.

IMPEACHMENT/STOP THE MADNESS:

- Democrats can't beat President Trump's record of success at the ballot box, so their only option was to pursue a baseless, fact-free impeachment inquiry.
